SEVERE ALLERGIC REACTION (ANAPHYLAXIS) WHAT TO WATCH OUT FOR'

- Difficulty/noisy breathing
- Swelling of tongue
- Swelling/tightness in throat
- Difficulty talking and/or hoarse voice
- Wheeze or persistent cough
- Loss of consciousness and/or collapse
- Pale and floppy (young children)

WHAT TO DO

- 1 INJECT EPIPEN® (adrenaline) auto-injector immediately
- **2 Use blue inhaler** if prescribed
- **3 Ring 999** and emergency contact
- 4 If symptoms don't improve, you can administer a second EpiPen® (adrenaline) auto-injector after 5-15 minutes

MILD-TO-MODERATE ALLERGIC REACTION WHAT TO WATCH OUT FOR*

• Red raised itchy rash • Swelling of face/lips/eyelids • Being sick • Stomach ache

WHAT TO DO

- **1 Stay calm** sit or lie down, avoid exercise
- 2 Take an antihistamine
- **3 Ring** emergency contact
- 4 Watch out for worsening of symptoms
- **5** Have your **EpiPen®** (adrenaline) auto-injector ready just in case

HOW TO USE YOUR EPIPEN® (ADRENALINE) AUTO-INJECTOR OR EPIPEN® JR (ADRENALINE) AUTO-INJECTOR

STEP 1

Lie down with legs slightly elevated or sit up if breathing is difficult



STEP 2

Grasp your **EpiPen®** (adrenaline) auto-injector in your dominant hand with the blue safety cap closest to your thumb and remove cap



STEP 3

Hold your **EpiPen®** (adrenaline) autoinjector about 10 cm away from your leg and **swing and jab** the orange tip into the upper outer thigh at a 90° angle

Hold in place for 10 seconds

Remove the **EpiPen®** (adrenaline) auto-injector and massage injection site for at least 10 seconds



STEP 4

You must dial 999, ask for an ambulance and state 'anaphylaxis' (pronounced 'anna – fill – axis') immediately after administering the EpiPen® (adrenaline) auto-injector

Do not get up, stay lying down or seated until you have been assessed by a paramedic

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
